What is a Knowledge Pack?

A [Knowledge Pack](#) is a collection of credits that offers a flexible way for you to access the IET Digital Library, to download journal and conference articles and eBook chapters.

What are the benefits?

As an IET member you can now enjoy access to this valuable knowledge for your own research and [CPD](#), whenever you need it.

As part of the membership benefit, you will receive five free credits to download content from the Digital Library on 1 January every year, with the opportunity to purchase additional credits throughout the year, allowing more downloads.

What is the Digital Library?

The [Digital Library](#) is global repository of high-quality science, engineering and technology content that holds over 190,000 technical documents, including nearly 400 eBooks, over 1,300 conference publications, and over 70,000 journal articles.
