**1. Issue**

To agree the approach for creating Council's proposals on IET Strategy for submission to the Strategy Input Meeting on 9-10 June 2022.

**2. Timing**

Council meeting, 24 March 2022.

**3. For Recommendation**

3.1. Council is invited to approve the following approach for creating Council's proposals on IET Strategy for submission to the Strategy Input Meeting on 9-10 June 2022:

3.1.1. Council members will review a draft paper to be made available online before 24 March 2022;

3.1.2. Council members will comment and make input online, or submit comments by email to Ian MacGillivray by email by Thursday, 7 April 2022;

3.1.3. the paper will be updated and Council members will be invited to approve it out-of-committee, for submission to the Strategy Input Meeting.

**4. Background**

4.1. The Trustees and members of Council will attend the Strategy Input Meeting at Savoy Place, London, on 9-10 June 2022. It is customary for Council to submit its proposals on strategic issues to this meeting each year.

4.2. The outcome of the World Café discussions on the topics of Technicians and Members will feature in the proposals to be submitted to the Strategy Input Meeting. Plans for these proposals are already established and underway.

4.3. To date this Session, Council has not expressed a formal opinion on the IET Strategy 2030. This paper proposes an approach for creating Council's proposals on IET Strategy for submission to the Strategy Input Meeting over the coming weeks.

**5. Comments on the IET Strategy 2030**

5.1. At its meeting on 14 January 2022 Council noted a report on the IET Strategy 2030 (CO(21)24). The paper outlined the changes made since the previous version published in 2020. Several members commented on the new version of the Strategy.

- 5.2. A number of members have posted comments on the on Yammer within the Office 365 collaborative platform. The thread of information and comments also covers the previous version of the Strategy from 2021.
- 5.3. The paper for Council approval out-of-committee will be drawn from this material plus any additional input from members by Thursday, 7 April 2022. The aim will be to produce a concise paper that conveys major themes, rather than comments on specific areas in detail. It is judged that this approach will best stimulate a constructive dialogue on the matter at the Strategy Input Meeting.
