


## 4 Impact

## What can you expect from us

### – Reimbursing fees


By supporting your technical employees with their membership and Professional Registration fees you will not only provide them with many development opportunities but also enhance the culture of professionalism within your organisation.

# Development

## Mentoring


We can help you establish or improve the mentoring of early career engineers within your company. We can run campaigns to encourage your Professionally Registered engineers to become mentors and provide mentor training.


